





ERASMUS MOBILITY IN FINLAND TO RETHINK SUSTAINABLE EDUCATION

From 18 to 28 March 2025, pupils, teachers and NGOs from the four partner countries of the ODDience2030 project will be meeting in Finland for an Erasmus mobility programme based on jobshadowing and artistic and immersive exploration. This innovative programme aims to transform teaching and learning through sustainable education, by combining intercultural experiences, educational prototyping and social arts practices.

ODDience 2030: Immersive mobility to reinvent education and global citizenship

The Oddience 2030 eLab and Campfire programs joined in on mobility to create context for a transformative experience-led process for students. Teachers and community partner NGOs. These two programs aim to offer a space to empower education ecosystems, cultivate diverse perspectives, and equip them as global citizens to reimagine and co-create more sustainable future(s).

Through prototyping accelerators, a different way of job-shadowing, cross-cultural student exchange, and immersive exploration of ecotones, bioregionalism, and social arts, first with eLab program in place situated in Vantaa and then traveling to Lapland, participants will have the opportunity to:

Sharpen their attention on prototyping efforts, accelerating their work while noticing an ecosystem of support.

An educational trip to Finland: immersion, creativity and sustainable learning

Students will start by experiencing the Finnish school system and form international relationships during workshops and excursions. Immerse into a place based journey to Lapland as "long way up Finland". They will continue to engage in a "deep time walk" to connect to oneself, different cultures, and the place they are in, utilizing methodologies such as social presencing theater and social arts. Explore the Indigenous ways of nature, further opening up the mind-heart-will through cultural and ecological experiences as top be come Oddience2030 Stewards of teaching and learning with sustainability

The eLab prototyping program and Campfire social arts programs are facilitated by the training program partner <u>Actonlearning.org</u>, and students' international experience is organised and facilitated by <u>Vaskivuori</u> <u>High School</u>.
